A college internship at Rise helps students apply the knowledge and skills learned in the classroom with meaningful and real time opportunities in the City of St. Louis and St. Louis County in Missouri along with Madison and St. Clair counties in Illinois where Rise serves. The experience with Rise will assist college juniors, seniors, and graduate students develop their project and program management skills in addition to creating professional connections.

Expectations. Rise's Rising Star internship program will run from May 15 to September 15, 2021. Rise seeks students who are professional, collaborative and independent self-starters. Some of the duties of Rise practicum students may involve assisting with the following:
